## Cambridge AICE

- AICE offers internationally recognized college courses tailored to students' individual interests, abilities, strengths, and future plans.
- Since 1998, SAHS students have been earning the AICE Diploma Award as well as college course credit through their success on AICE examinations.
- The Cambridge courses are not only among the highest level, most rigorous courses available to students in the St. Johns County School District, but recognized internationally in over 160 countries.
- AICE courses are awarded an extra 1.0 GPA quality point for each passing grade. Pre-AICE = an extra .5 GPA point.
- Students who earn the **AICE Diploma Award** and have logged 100 hours of community service qualify for the **Florida Academic Scholars Bright Futures Scholarship**. (SAT/ACT scores and GPA requirements are waived.)

## AICE Diploma Award Requirements

Students must **pass** a total of seven (7) **AICE** Examinations from at least three subject groupings, and the core.

## Pre-AICE

### International General Certificate of Secondary Education (IGCSE)

- IGCSE provides students with a foundation for success at higher level AICE courses.
- IGCSE develops students' abilities in oral and investigative techniques, problem solving, initiative, and teamwork.

## Fun Facts

- AICE was successfully piloted between 1997 and 2000 in Florida (at SAHS).
- AICE Students at SAHS have excelled in their performance on Cambridge exams, receiving the Cambridge International "Top in the USA" Award for scoring the highest mark in the U.S. on the Physics, History, Art & Design, Math, French and Thinking Skills exams.
- A FACTS.org study of High School Acceleration programs, showed AICE and Dual Enrollment Students earn the highest percentage of postsecondary (college) credit (98%).
- AICE students at SAHS enjoy participating in other academies, activities, and sports programs.
- Since 1997, the AICE program at high schools has grown and is now available in more than 30 states: including over 100 High Schools in Florida alone.
