Dual Enrollment

The Academy of Law and Homeland Security partners with St Johns River State College to offer dual enrollment (college and high school credit) classes on our campus at St Augustine High School. Students can earn a **College Credit Certificate as Homeland Security Specialist** by completing the following courses:

CJ 1020 - Intro to Criminal Justice
CJ 1100 - Criminal Law
CJ 1006 - Police and Society

Credits can also be used towards earning degrees at SJR State such as Associate of Science in Criminal Justice Technology.
